
Immigration Rules For Children Entering And Leaving South Africa Effective From 1 June 2015





All children under 18 years old travelling to or from South Africa are required to travel with their unabridged birth certificate in addition to their passport from 1 June 2015.

Children Travelling With Both Parents



Where both parents are travelling with their own children, they must produce a valid passport and an unabridged birth certificate for each child reflecting the particulars of the parents of the child.

What is an unabridged birth certificate?

An original or certified copy of the birth certificate including the full details of the parents.


Children Travelling With One Parent



In the case of one parent travelling with a child, the parent must produce a valid passport and an unabridged birth certificate of the child and one of the following -

- (i) consent in the form of an affidavit from the other parent authorising him or her to enter South Africa with the child;
- (ii) a court order granting full parental responsibilities and rights or legal guardianship in respect of the child;
- (iii) where applicable, a death certificate of the other parent

Children Travelling With A Guardian Or Tour Leader



Where a person is travelling with a child who is not his or her biological child, he or she must produce a valid passport and an unabridged birth certificate for the child and -

- (i) an affidavit from the parents or legal guardian of the child confirming that the person in question has permission to travel with the child;
- (ii) copies of the identity documents or passports of the parents or legal guardian of the child; and
- (iii) contact details of the parents / legal guardian of the child
